- Henna takes time! Applying large and/or intricate designs cannot be done quickly
- Long-lasing and deeply-colored henna is dependent upon your skin's preparation, how long you allow the stain to absorb, and your aftercare. See the Additional Information for Prep and Aftercare instructions.
- Once the dried paste is removed, the color appears a light orange. After 24-48 hours, the color deepens to its final, reddish-brown color.
- I only apply henna to hands/arms
- I only use traditional henna; I do not use Jagua (black henna)





Pre-Appointment

To allow for the deepest, most long-lasting henna stain possible:

- Exfoliate the area well
- Consider removing hair in the art area
- · Avoid lotions, oils, and moisturizers for several days beforehand

Before Paste Removal

- Leave the paste on for as long as possible, ideally 6-8 hours, or even overnight for a deeper stain
- To keep your mehendi moist and encourage a darker color, you can apply a mixture of lemon juice and sugar to your DRIED paste. The acidity of the lemon helps to oxidize the henna, while the sugar keeps it hydrated. Leave this mixture on for a few hours or overnight for best results
- Keep warm this will help with further dye release

Paste Removal

- Do not wash paste off with water; instead, scrape or brush the dry past off.
- The henna stain will initially appear orange and gradually darken to a reddish-brown over the next 48 hours
